

### 2017-2018 District Speech Contest

#### Instructions for Teachers and Students

Thank you for participating in the 2017-2018 Rotary District 5190 Speech Contest

#### **Important Points to Know**

- 1. In most areas, the speech contest has three levels. First is the local club contest, held between February and March, 2018. The second is an area contest, held between March and April, 2018. The final level is the District Speech contest, to be held at the District Conference on *May 19, 2018, 9:30am at Atlantis Casino Resort Spa, Reno, NV*. STUDENTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL THREE LEVELS TO ENTER THE COMPETITION.
- 2. Only the winner at each level advances to the next level. Club and Area contests have 2-5 contestants; the District has 7-13. The cash prizes at the district level are  $$1,000 (1^{st}), $750 (2^{nd}), and $500 (3^{rd})$ . Club and area prizes are the responsibility of the participating clubs.
- 3. Contest rules are available at your local school or Rotary Club.
- 4. Your local Rotary club is responsible for furnishing you with all of the information needed to compete at each level of the contest.
- 5. A student may enter only one club contest in their own area.

The theme this year is: "Rotary is Making a Difference. What About Me?"

#### **Speech Contest Rules**

Theme: "Rotary is Making a Difference. What About Me?"

Time: 5-7 Minutes

Entrants: Must be from District 5190 clubs in grades 9 - 12

Club Prizes: To be determined by club

Area Prizes: To be determined by participating clubs

District Prizes: \$1,00 for 1<sup>st</sup> Place, \$750 for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, \$500 for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place

#### **CONTEST RULES**

Notes: Contestant may use written notes at the club contest ONLY

Microphone: A microphone must be used at the District contest

Props: No displays, props, or prompting is allowed

Judges: Use 4 judges and 1 tiebreaker at all contests. They may be Rotarians

Arrival Time: All contestants MUST arrive at contest location NO LATER than 10

minutes before the start of the contest. Late arrivals will be

DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS.

#### SUGGESTED COMPLETION TIMELINES

Club Contest: February – March, 2018 Deadline

Area Contest: Before April 15, 2018 Deadline

All Area Speech contestant finalist names and contact information is due to Jeanne Schmidt Herron no later than April 15, 2018.

District Speech contest is on May 19, 2018, 9:30am At Atlantis Casino Resort Spa, Reno, NV

Contestants must be available to speak at both the Area and District contests in order to enter the club contest. A student may only speak at one club in their area.
